Applicants can be farmers, farm managers or others involved in agribusiness sectors with a minimum of 5 year's experience. Applications for the course must be completed on the Application Form and received by Harper Adams no later than 31st July 2019. Interviews will be held by invitation at Harper Adams University on Thursday 12th September 2019. The awards for places on the course will be made within 2 weeks of the interviews. The course will take place at Harper Adams University in Shropshire and our nominated University in the Netherlands. Participation in the course requires commitment to <u>full</u> attendance of the individual three week residential programme.

Course Fee & Funding
