

In order to receive inter library loans via electronic delivery a plug-in called Fileopen needs to be installed.

All on campus student PCs already have Fileopen installed.

To install Fileopen on a personal computer the URL is provided below. There is also a link to the British Library to download a test document to show whether the installation has worked properly.

There are a few things you will need to be aware of when receiving articles via electronic delivery.

- You can only print the article off once (the first time you open the document).
- If you are opening the file on Google Chrome, you
 will need to disable the in-built PDF viewer so that
 FileOpen will be used. A guide on how to do this can

- You have 30 days from when the file was sent to open it.
- Once opened the file will be accessible for 3
 years on the PC it was originally opened on. After
 this it will disappear.
