

The Harper Adams University Hospitality Scholarship Application 2016/17

Who can apply?

The HAU Hospitality Scholarship is open to all 2nd year BSc or final year FdSc students studying Food & Consumer Studies or Food, Nutrition and Wellbeing, or any Agri-business related course, enrolled in full-time education at the University.

Opportunities

The successful scholarship recipient will receive a **one-off payment valued up to a maximum of £1,500**. The award will be paid in two equal parts; half in February 2017 and the remaining balance in May 2017.

Payment is conditional on the scholar remaining registered as a full-time student at Harper Adams. They must pass all modules of study during the continuation of the scholarship and submit at least one written report to the Development Trust prior to the receipt of their second payment.

This is a competitive award, evaluated on merit of the submitted application, along with academic achievements to date and interview. The decision of the HAU Hospitality Scholarship Panel is **FINAL** and they reserve the right to withdraw their award at any time should they feel this action is required.

Shortlisted applicants will be invited for interview at Harper Adams on **Thursday 8 December 2016.** Please note that an alternative interview date <u>cannot</u> be arranged.

Application Process

On A4 paper, (no more than 2 pages) single-sided sheets, (font NO smaller than Arial 11) please explain why you would be interested in receiving the HAU Hospitality Scholarship.

Please include the following information:

- 1. Why you have selected to study your chosen course.
- 2. Why the receipt of this award would make a difference to you financially.
- 3. A brief CV maximum of 2 pages, single sided, Arial 11. Please do not staple your application.

In the event that the HAU Hospitality Scholarship Panel requests UCAS and/or academic information to assess your application, your authorisation and signature are required. In addition, this allows HAU and the sponsor to publicise your scholarship. Please indicate your consent below.
