

# The Jean Jackson Charitable Trust Scholarship Application 2016/17

### Who can apply?

The Jean Jackson Charitable Trust Scholarship is open to all 1<sup>st</sup> year FdSc Countryside Management students, or 2<sup>nd</sup> year BSc Countryside Management, Countryside and Environment Management students or Wildlife Conservation with Natural Resource Management students studying at Harper Adams University who either originate from the county of Shropshire or will be undertaking a voluntary placement in Shropshire. (Please note: the voluntary placement must be unpaid, but can however offer accommodation, with a not for profit organisation/registered Charity).

#### **Opportunities**

The successful recipient(s) will receive an award valued at £10,000. The award will be made payable over the placement year and will be divided equally over the number of months of placement taken.

Payment is conditional on the scholar remaining registered as a full-time student at Harper Adams. They must pass all modules of study during the continuation of the scholarship and submit at least one written report to the Development Trust. Should the scholar's placement terminate for any reason then the scholarship will also cease. This is a competitive award, evaluated on merit of the submitted application, academic achievements to date and interview. The decision of the Jean Jackson Charitable Trust Scholarship Panel is FINAL and they reserve the right to withdraw their award at any time should they feel this action is required.

Shortlisted applicants are required to attend a panel interview at HAU on Friday 20 January 2017 Please note that an alternative interview date <u>cannot</u> be arranged.

## **Application Process**

On A4 paper, (no more than 2 pages) single-sided sheets, (font NO smaller than Arial 11), please explain why you would be interested in receiving the Jean Jackson Charitable Trust Scholarship. Please include the following information:

- 1. Why you wish to work in the voluntary sector.
- 2. What skills, knowledge and understanding you hope to gain from doing a voluntary placement.
- 3. How you will use this money in the context of your long term career development.
- 4. What difference would the receipt of a scholarship from the Jean Jackson Charitable Trust make to the pursuit of your goals.
- 5. A brief CV maximum of 2 pages, single sided, font Arial 11. Please do not staple your application.

In the event that the Jean Jackson Charitable Trust Scholarship Committee requests UCAS and/or academic information to assess your application, your authorisation and signature are required. In addition, this allows HAU and the sponsor to publicise your scholarship. Please indicate your consent below.
