



The Jerman Scholarship Application 2016/17

The Jerman Scholarship is open to all **2nd Year BSc, Final Year BSc** or **Final Year FdSc** students enrolled in full-time education at Harper Adams University. In memory of Mr and Mrs Jerman, **Welsh students** are strongly encouraged to apply; however, this scholarship is not exclusive and all eligible students **considering a career in the rural community** are welcome to apply. **Preference may also be given to students at time of interview who are not in receipt of any other award.**

The successful scholarship recipient(s) will each receive a **one-off payment of up to £3000**. The award will be paid in two equal parts; half to be paid in February 2017 and the balance in May 2017.

Payment is conditional on the scholar remaining registered as a full-time student at Harper Adams. They must pass all modules of study during the continuation of the scholarship and submit at least one written report to the Development Trust prior to the receipt of their second payment.

This is a competitive award, evaluated on the merit of the submitted application, academic achievements to date and interview. The decision of the Jerman Scholarship Panel is **FINAL** and they reserve the right to withdraw their award at any time should they feel this action is required.

Shortlisted applicants are required to attend a panel interview at HAU on **Thursday 24 November 2016**.

Please note that an alternative interview date cannot be arranged.

Application Process

On A4 paper, (no more than 2 pages), single-sided sheets (**font NO smaller than Arial 11**) please explain why you would be interested in receiving the Jerman Scholarship.

Please include the following information:

1. Why you have selected to study your chosen course.
2. Discuss the future relevance your chosen direction of study will have on/to the rural economy.
3. A brief CV – maximum of **2 pages, single sided, Arial 11**. Please do not staple your application.

In the event that the Jerman Scholarship Panel requests UCAS and/or academic information to assess your application, your authorisation and signature are required. In addition, this allows HAU and the sponsor to publicise your scholarship. Please indicate this below.
