

The CLA Charitable Trust Scholarship Application

The CLA Charitable Trust Scholarship is open to all **2nd Year BSc** students studying **Rural Enterprise and Land Management** or **Rural Property Management** at Harper Adams University.

The successful recipient will receive an award of **£4,000** for each academic year they are enrolled at HAU. The award will be paid in 2 equal parts, half in February 2017 and the remaining balance in May 2017.

Payment is conditional on the scholar remaining registered as a full-time student at Harper Adams. They must pass all modules of study during the continuation of the scholarship and submit at least one written report to the Development Trust prior to the receipt of their second payment.

This is a competitive award, evaluated on merit of the submitted application, academic achievements to date and interview. The decision of the CLA Charitable Trust Scholarship Panel is **FINAL** and they reserve the right to withdraw their award at any time should they feel this action is required.

Shortlisted applicants are required to attend a panel interview at HAU on **Monday 28 November 2016**.

Please note that an alternative interview date cannot be arranged.

Application Process

On A4 paper (no more than 2 pages), single-sided sheets, (**font NO smaller than Arial 11**), please explain why you would be interested in receiving the CLA Charitable Trust scholarship.

Please include the following information:

1. Why you have selected to study your chosen course.
2. What you hope to achieve from your chosen course.
3. What contribution you feel you can make to land management as a result of receiving this award.
4. What difference would the receipt of a scholarship from the CLA CT make to the pursuit of your goals.
5. A brief CV - **maximum of 2 pages, single sided, Arial 11**. Please do not staple your application.

In the event that the CLA Charitable Trust requests UCAS and/or academic information to assess your application, your authorisation and signature are required. In addition, this allows HAU and the sponsor to publicise your scholarship. Please indicate your consent below.
