ACCOMMODATION CHECKLIST:

The following list is for your guidance only, for those of you who have lived away from home before you may not need to follow this list. However, for those of you venturing away from home for the first time please use the following checklist to ensure that you have everything you could possibly want and need during your residence in Halls. Please bear in mind that the items listed here are just the basics feel free to add your own essentials to the list!

ALL STUDENTS WILL REQUIRE:

- 1 Single duvet
- 2 Single duvet covers
- 2 Single fitted or flat sheets
- 2 Pillows
- 4 Pillowcases
- 2 Bath towels
- 2 Hand towels
- 1 Laundry bag
- Clothes hangers
- Laundry detergent

YOU MAY ALSO WISH TO BRING:

- 1 Bedside lamp (this will need to be PAT tested)
- A floor rug
- A blanket or throw
- Television (you will need to arrange your own TV licence)
- Kettle (this will need to be PAT tested)
- Laptop (this will need to be PAT tested)
- Mini fridge (this will need to be PAT tested)

You **CANNOT** bring the following items:

- Electric Fire
- Heaters
- Cooker
- Toaster
- Microwave
- Sofa
- Armchair
- Candles
- Chip Pans
- Standard Refrigerator
- Plug In Fairy Lights
- Christmas Trees over 3ft/90cm
- Gas or Wood Fired BBQ

PAT TESTING

In accordance with University Regulations all students are reminded that it is your responsibility to ensure that any electrical/electronic appliance you bring into the halls is electronically sound and has had a Portable Appliance Test (a valid PAT Certificate will be required).

If electrical items such as electric kettles, televisions, mini fridges/coolers, speakers, and computers are brand new (out of the box), you do not need to carry out PAT testing, but you will need to provide the receipt to prove when it has been purchased. Inspections will be done at random at the start of the academic year.

Where an electrical item fails the PAT test, it will be removed by the Estates and Facilities Department or Domestic Services Department for safe keeping. The student will be advised in person, or a card will be left. The student will be required to arrange and pay for a repair and the item will be re-tested and if it passes, returned to the student. Where an item is not repaired successfully within six weeks, it will be disposed of via the correct route by the Estates Department.

PERSONAL PROPERTY AND MONEY

Harper Adams University is working in partnership with Endsleigh, the UK's No. 1 student insurance provider, to protect the contents inside your room. Before you arrive, register below for My Endsleigh so you can confirm your accommodation insurance cover.

SELF-SERVICE LAUNDRY
