

## 2023-24 HAU Accommodation Info Sheet

- Annual charge includes regular cleaning (as appropriate) as well as heating, lighting, internet, Endsleigh standard room contents insurance, and for those in catered accommodation three meals a day Monday to Friday (term time). Meals are also available to self-catered students throughout the week on a 'pay as you go' basis.
- Residents benefit from out of hours support, 24h security and on-campus parking.
- All campus accommodation is self-service laundry.
- HKVets students have the option to extend their accommodation on campus beyond the end of their accommodation agreement if required to stay in the area to complete further course-related experience, although they may be required to move accommodation.

### Eligibility:

- Firm offer (conditional or unconditional)
- HKVets as 1st choice
- Accepted offer on UCAS
- Unable to apply while HKVets is an insurance choice

## Applying for accommodation:

- Once Admissions have processed your acceptance of the course offer on UCAS, we will send you an invite (via email) to apply for you accommodation online in the Spring.
- Information, including application step-by-step guide, will be sent to eligible students and is also available on the [HKVetS website](#).
- You will not find out your host campus until later in the year, so we strongly recommend selecting room preferences for BOTH campuses'.
- The application process takes a few of minutes.

## Accepting your HAU accommodation offer:

- Accommodation offers will be made at the end of August. We will write to all applicants with a confirmed date closer to the time. Once offers are made, you will have 7 days to accept it.
- £300 deposit payable as part of accommodation offer acceptance process, which will be refundable at the end of the fixed term licence agreement (minus deductions for damages or other outstanding accommodation charges).
- Able to pay in one lump sum before registration day or in termly instalments, scheduled in line with student loan payments.

## Important!

- Keep contact details updated with our Admissions team, especially your email address. If possible, avoid using a school email address.
- Let us know if you have medical or other special requirements to be considered during the allocation process. You will be prompted as part of your application and you will need to provide suitable and recent evidence. Disclosing at a later stage means we may not be able to put in place reasonable adjustments.
- If out of the country, when the time comes to make your application, you can get someone else to do it, but make sure they know your preferences, etc. The application process requires access to your email inbox.
- We cannot accept applications over the telephone or via email.

## Prefer to live off campus?

- We are able to assist with finding accommodation off-campus. The earlier you tell us, the better.
- In the summer months, rooms and student houses may be available, which can be circulated to those who express interest as well as details for students wanting to rent with other students.
- There are student rooms/houses available off campus in all year round, although lodgings and smaller flats are much more limited.

## Accommodation in 2<sup>nd</sup> year and beyond:

- HAU-hosted students usually live off campus in Newport or adjacent villages of Edgmond, Adeney and Tibberton. Rent average £75-£95 exc. bills or £95-£125 inc. bills.
- Majority of accommodation is in houses of 4 and 5 in residential areas. There are also lodgings and a couple smaller flats available.
- 1st year students are not encouraged to sign up for accommodation off campus until at least after Christmas, after we have done our housing forum and detail of properties available are published.
- Year 0 students (Extended Foundation degree) do not automatically qualify for accommodation on campus in the following year, but requests will be considered subject to availability.
- If you choose to move somewhere in between the two campuses, we will assist you in the process of forging the necessary links to secure accommodation in your area of choice.
