# Step 1 – key info

---

# Step 2 - application

---

- The invite to apply for accommodation will come via email to eligible applicants;
- Invites will be sent in batches, linked to the date you have accepted your course offer;
- The invite will include a link to complete an online accommodation application. This should not be shared with other applicants to avoid gaining unfair advantage - submissions will be monitored;
- You are encouraged to select accommodation preferences at **BOTH** sites because at this stage site allocation is not yet confirmed;
- If you do not express your preferences for both sites now, allocated sites may not be able to meet your accommodation preference list.





# Step 4 – form (page 2)

The application process will now take you through questions relating to your accommodation preferences.

## Do not require campus accommodation

If you do not require on-campus accommodation, please select

**No, I intend to live off-campus.**

You will also be required to advise us of allergies to dogs.

If you might require assistance in securing off-campus accommodation, it may be useful to provide any relevant information on medical conditions, disabilities, other health conditions or requirements which might be helpful when assisting you in identifying appropriate off-campus accommodation.

Then click on the submit button to complete your application.

If your host has not been confirmed to you and you only select accommodation at one campus it will not guarantee that you will be allocated that campus by your host institution and may result in less favourable accommodation options being available in August.

- When you select the individual campuses, the different accommodation choices will appear.
- You will be asked to rate your top 3 choices available at each campus, with 1 being your most preferred choice.
