The Gary Baker Award (by The Worshipful Company of Butchers) Application Information 2023/24

The Gary Baker Award has been established to honour the memory of the late Gary Baker. The endowment through which the Award is made is in the gift of the Baker Family and is administered by The Worshipful Company of Butchers

The Gary Baker Award is open to **Final Year BSc**, or **Final Year FdSc** students studying **Agriculture, Animal Science, Agri-Food Marketing or Food Technology** at Harper Adams University, who are interested in pursuing a career in the **meat processing industry or associated sectors** (e.g. food animal production, meat technology or meat packaging businesses).

The successful scholarship recipient will receive a **one-off payment of £1,000**. The award will be paid in two equal parts; half in February 2024 and the remaining balance in May 2024.

Payment is conditional on the scholar remaining registered as a full-time student at Harper Adams. They must pass all modules of study during the continuation of the scholarship and submit a letter of thanks for the sponsor to the Development Trust prior to the receipt of each payment.

This is a competitive award which will be evaluated on the merit of the submitted application, academic achievements to date and interview. The Development Trust embraces diversity and promotes equality of opportunity and access to higher education. The Trust has been successful in supporting a wide range of students. It strongly encourages applications from students of all backgrounds. Where there are two applicants of equal merit, preference will be given to applicants who are from backgrounds that are underrepresented in UK higher education.

The decision of The Gary Baker Award Panel is **FINAL** and they reserve the right to withdraw their award at any time should they feel this action is required.

Shortlisted applicants are required to attend a panel interview on **Tuesday 17 October 2023**
Please note that an alternative interview date **cannot** be arranged

The presentation of The Gary Baker Award will be made by the Master of the Worshipful Company of Butchers at a Court Lunch in London.

Application Process

To be eligible to apply for this scholarship you must:

- **Have spent your industrial placement period in a UK-based red meat production and/or processing and/or relating manufacturing business. Students who have worked on farms in red meat production (beef, pork and lamb/mutton) or in meat processing businesses (abattoirs and/or red meat packing companies or meat products manufacturing etc.) are eligible to apply.**

Your Application

Your application must include the following three documents, which should be saved in PDF format, named 1 Consent Form, 2 Covering Letter and 3 CV and emailed to DevelopmentTrust@harper-adams.ac.uk by 12pm noon on **Friday 6 October 2023**. Email subject: Gary Baker Award

1. **Consent Form** – this must be completed and signed to show that you have read and understood the Privacy & Data Protection Notice
2. **A covering letter** of no more than 1,000 words, addressed to Mrs Doris Taylor and including the following information
 - A reflection of your industrial placement, communicating your understanding of the red meat sector;
 - A short statement explaining your future career plans;
 - What difference the receipt of this award would make to the pursuit of your goals.
3. **Full CV** – no more than 2 pages
